Current Status	<p>Ministry of Health & Family Welfare launched an online portal namely Health Management Information System (HMIS) during 2008. The purpose of the portal is collection of timely information/ data from all States/ UTs for assessing the performance of government hospitals/ health facilities and monitoring the implementation of various schemes under NHM. At present, more than 1.96 government hospitals (including District Hospital, Sub District Hospitals, CHCs, PHCs and Sub Centres) are reporting service delivery data on monthly basis and Infrastructure related data on annual basis.</p> <p>Government hospitals/ health facilities are being monitored using various reports based on HMIS data. The most important report among these is " Grading of CHCs" in which grades are being assigned to Government hospitals/ health facilities on the basis of Infrastructure availability and service delivery data. This grading of CHCs is available in Public Domain of HMIS portal.</p>
